



Boracay Emergency Employment Program Adjustment Measures Program

AMENDED GUIDELINES

D.O. 191-A, SERIES OF 2018
Effective 1 August 2018

The DOLE BEEP Adjustment Measures Program (AMP) offers a comprehensive package of assistance to Filipino formal sector workers affected by the temporary closure of Boracay Island. It aims to enhance their employability and competitiveness, as well as mitigate the adverse economic impact of the island's rehabilitation.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Financial Support (FS)

Uniform financial assistance equivalent to 50% of the prevailing minimum wage in the region (i.e. Php 4,205.50 per month) provided monthly for a maximum period of six months, regardless of displacement status

Employment Facilitation

Access to available job opportunities suitable to the beneficiary's qualifications

Training

Trainings fit to the needs of the beneficiary for skills enhancement and employability

2-STEP APPLICATION PROCESS

1

Submit complete requirements to the BEEP Operations Center – DOLE Satellite Desk, DOLE Regional Office VI or one of its Field of Offices; or to the nearest DOLE Regional/Field/Satellite Offices for workers who have gone back to their hometown.

DOLE RO VI shall evaluate the application within 3 working days upon receipt, after which the applicant may expect either a Notice of Approval or Denial through registered mail or electronic mail.

Note: Applications submitted to DOLE Offices other than DOLE RO VI will take an additional two working days for endorsement and processing.

DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

Present original copies to the concerned DOLE Office for validation.



Photocopy of Certificate of Employment or RO VI Profile of Displaced Workers



Photocopy of any government-issued ID

HOW WILL THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT BE RELEASED TO BENEFICIARIES?

Upon approval of their application, beneficiaries may expect the release of their first tranche of FS by the end of the reference month **either through direct deposit to their submitted Land Bank of the Philippines Savings Account or through money remittance.**

For applications submitted before the 5th of the reference month, the first tranche of FS will be issued on the following month's scheduled release.

Subsequent FS tranches will be release every end of the following months of program coverage.

WHAT ARE THE RELAXED REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONTINUED RELEASE OF FS?

Beneficiaries must submit, on or before 26 September 2018:

- a. two (2) proofs of active search for employment or job contact, and
- b. one (1) proof of attendance to any training conducted by a government agency.

ARE PRIOR BENEFICIARIES ENTITLED TO A DIFFERENTIAL FS?

Yes. While the original BEEP AMP

guidelines distinguished retained workers from displaced workers and allot different FS amounts to them, the amended guidelines forgoes this distinction and grants uniform FS to affected workers regardless of their status.

Existing beneficiaries and those who have completed the program before the effectivity of the amended BEEP AMP guidelines shall receive in lump sum a differential FS equivalent to the difference between the uniform FS and the received FS amount. They shall continue to receive the uniform FS amount on a monthly basis until the end of their approved program coverage.
