"WHY SHOULD WE HIRE YOU?"

Here are the things that you can include when responding to this question


- 1. That **you have the necessary skills that they are looking for**. You can briefly state that you have the "know how" for the job and the ability to perform the tasks and duties required by the job. Don't explain yourself- just briefly state this.
- 2. That **your job experience is aligned with the job description**. You need to verbalize your strengths, skills, abilities, and willingness to work for the company and that you can go an extra mile if needed.
- 3. Mention your accomplishments, or awards in the field but only the ones that are relevant for the job that you're applying for. For example, if you were given an award in school for winning a Quiz Bee competition and your applying for a Sales position- you cannot use this achievement as a good reason since it doesn't directly apply to the job. On the other hand, if you received an award for the Best Thesis presentation, you should definitely say this.
- 4. **Provide at least 3 soft skills that you have**. These are your skills that relates to your ability to interact with other people such as being a team player, good listener and having a good sense of humor. There might be more soft skills that you possess which you aren't really fully aware of. Take a look at the complete list of soft skills in this list and pick three that you may already have.
- 5. Your willingness to do the job and show your enthusiasm to be part of the company. This will make you a cut above the rest especially if you show it during the job interview. When saying this, make sure to increase your level of energy. Smiling while saying it will also make it a lot more convincing.
- 6. **Give concrete examples of successful projects that you completed**. It doesn't necessarily even have to be your own project. It can be a team project which produce positive results for your former employer or school work. Citing concrete examples are a great way of selling yourself to the interviewer.
