The establishment of Networks of Guidance Counselors (NGCs), on the other hand, is a measure to augment the very few number of Registered Guidance Counselors (RGCs) in the country providing education, personal/motivational, and career guidance counseling to students and jobseekers. The provision CGEC and the services provided by the NGCs are also medium for sharing of relevant labor market information (LMI), trends, and issues which will guide the clients in their job search.
