

# BRIEFER ON THE COVID-19 ADJUSTMENT MEASURES PROGRAM

**CAMP** or COVID-19 Adjustment Measures Program, one of DOLE's COVID-19 mitigating measures, is a safety net program that provides a one-time financial assistance of Php 5,000.00 to workers in the formal sector (where employee-employer relationship exists), regardless of the status of employment (regular, casual, contractual, probationary).

## **CAMP under the Bayanihan to Heal As One Act (CAMP-BAYANIHAN 1)**

- Funds for CAMP under the Bayanihan to Heal As One Act (BAYANIHAN 1) was sourced from the realigned DOLE 2020 GAA.
- Upon program completion on 19 May 2020, the CAMP-BAYANIHAN 1 has benefitted **658,886 paid workers** from 34,227 establishments, with full disbursement amounting to **Php 3,311,152,079.70**. Financial assistance is credited to the individual ATM payroll account of workers or through money remittance centers.
- The acceptance of CAMP-BAYANIHAN 1 applications ceased on 15 April 2020 with more than 1.6 million workers from almost 60,000 establishments. About one (1) million workers from CAMP-BAYANIHAN 1 applications were not served given the limited funds. All applications have been shared with DOF and SSS for possible inclusion in the Small Business Wage Subsidy (SBWS) Program.

## **CAMP under the Bayanihan to Recover As One Act (CAMP-BAYANIHAN 2)**

- Funds for CAMP under the Bayanihan to Recover As One Act (BAYANIHAN 2) was sourced from Republic Act 11494.
- CAMP-BAYANIHAN 2 is divided into three (3) components: (1) CAMP-Regular; (2) CAMP for the Tourism Sector; and (3) CAMP for the Education Sector.
- As of 07 September 2021, the CAMP-BAYANIHAN 2 has benefitted **1,514,408 paid workers**, amounting to **Php 7.601 billion**. Financial assistance is credited to the individual ATM payroll account of workers or through money remittance centers.

**CAMP for Affected Workers in Areas under Alert Level 3 and up (CAMP3)**

- Funds for CAMP3 were sourced from the DOLE 2022 GAA.
- CAMP3 is being implemented to provide financial assistance to affected workers in the formal sector due to the declaration of Alert Level 3 or higher in various areas in the country which impacted the operations of establishments.
- As of 3 July 2022, the CAMP3 has benefitted **47,006 beneficiaries**, amounting to **Php 235 million**. Release of financial support via money remittance centers is still ongoing.
